The Loddon Mallee Regional Diabetes Pathways Project in 2009 aimed to develop regional diabetes pathways for early intervention and management of diabetes in the Loddon Mallee Region.

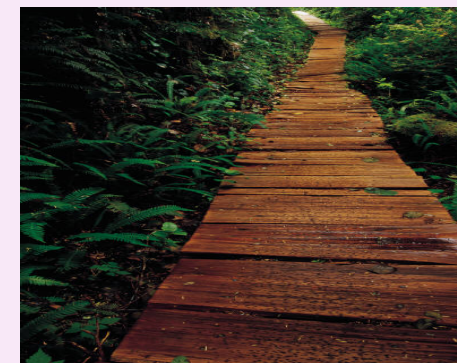
